

On October 23, 2020, the State of Idaho filed a *Petition* seeking commencement of a general adjudication of all rights arising under state or federal law to the use of surface and ground waters from the Clark Fork-Pend Oreille River Basin Water System and for the administration of such rights. A hearing on the *Petition* was held on January 21, 2021. In its *Notice of Filing Commencement Petition*, the Idaho Department of Water Resources proposed a process to defer the adjudication of domestic and stock water rights as defined by subsections (4) and (11) of section 42-1401A, Idaho Code. At the hearing, the State of Idaho and the United States requested additional time to discuss the proposed deferment process and to see if they can reach a stipulation concerning the same. Therefore, the Court will set February 25, 2021, as the deadline for the State of Idaho and the United States to inform the Court in writing whether they have been able to reach a stipulation.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that on or before February 25, 2021, the State of Idaho and the United States shall inform the Court in writing whether they have reached a stipulation concerning the deferment of domestic and stock water rights as defined by subsections (4) and (11) of section 42-1401A, Idaho Code, in the above-captioned matter.


