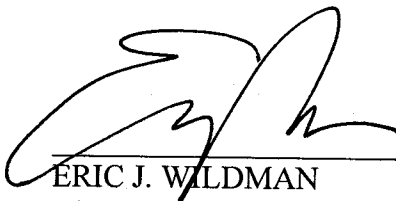
The Court entered its Memorandum Decision and Order on May 27, 2026. The Court entered its Judgment on that same date. On June 17, 2026, the City of Pocatello filed a Petition for Rehearing under Idaho Rule of Civil Procedure 84 and Idaho Appellate Rule 42. The City filed a brief in support on June 30, 2026. The Court in an exercise of its discretion will order oral argument and briefing on the on the Petition as set forth below.

THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING, THE FOLLOWING ARE HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Oral argument on the Petition for Rehearing will be heard on September 10, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. (Mountain Time) at the Snake River Basin Adjudication District Court, 253 3rd Avenue North, Twin Falls, Idaho. Oral argument will be conducted via Zoom pursuant to the attached instructions.
2. Responses to the Petition for Rehearing shall be filed on or before August 24, 2026.
3. The City of Pocatello may, if it so chooses, file a reply to the filed response on or before September 4, 2026.

1. How to join the meeting by telephone

- Dial the telephone number listed above.
- When prompted, enter the meeting ID provided above, followed by #.
- When prompted for a participant code (you will not have one), just enter #
- When prompted, enter the meeting password provided above, followed by #.

2. How to join the meeting online

- In your browser enter the link <https://www.zoom.us/join>
- Enter the meeting ID provided above. You may see a spinning wheel while the connection is made.
- Follow the instructions on the screen to either download and install the Zoom client, or to join the meeting via your web browser.
- When prompted, enter the meeting password provided above.
- Once the connection is made, you will be placed in a Waiting Room. A message will appear "Please wait, the meeting host will let you in soon."
- When court begins, you will be brought into the meeting from the Waiting Room.

3. Video (when joining online)

- Start your video by clicking **Start Video**, located in the lower-left corner of the window.

4. Audio

- Your sound will be on mute upon entry.
- Remain muted unless you are asked to speak to the court. Please be sure you have no background noise while speaking. You may be muted or removed from the hearing if causing a disruption.
- To unmute yourself, click the **Unmute** button, located in the lower-left corner of the window.
- If joining only by telephone, press *6 to toggle between unmute/mute.
